## **Designated Place of Safety (POS)**

"Each pupil shall be assigned a residence side designated place of safety. The Driver must account for each pupil at a designated place of safety before leaving. A place of safety is also applicable to adults being transported in County Board vehicles."

Ref: OAC 3301-83-13B6

Passengers must wait in a location clear of traffic and away from the bus stop. The purpose of the place of safety is to reduce as much as possible the potential of a student/individual being hit by a school bus while they are in the process of being picked up or dropped off.

The following are best practice guidelines for establishing POS.

- 1. The POS should be at least 10 or more steps away from the bus stop.
- 2. The POS should be far enough away from the bus so that the bus can proceed without any chance of the student/individual running back into the path of the bus as it leaves the designated stop.
- 3. When possible, the Driver should choose a stationary and recognizable object, such as a flag pole, garage door, or sign post.
- 4. The POS should be such that a driver can account for the location of the student/individual before moving the bus.
- 5. Drivers who do not believe a POS can be determined at a given stop should communicate with their supervisor and ask for assistance.
- 6. The POS for each student/individual will be identified on the route sheet.
