Nature Scavenger Hunts

What a great way to spend some quality family time!!!
You can use the nature scavenger hunt to the right or just let your child explore and find items. Try making and using the nature paint brushes below.

Painting with Nature Paint Brushes

To make the brushes you will need to take your child on a nature hunt to collect lots of interesting pieces of nature (ie. feathers, flowers, leaves, etc). Have fun looking for different textures and patterns and talking about the nature items and

what kind of print you think it will make. Don't forget to collect enough sticks for each paint brush you plan to make as you go too!

Making the paint brushes is easy. You will need elastic bands, string or tape to attach the piece of nature to the stick. If using elastic bands it is easiest to have the elastic bands already on the sticks so you can just slide the pieces of nature under the band and onto the sticks.

Set out a few colors of paint and a piece of paper and let your child explore the different patterns and textures the paint brushes make. Model how to dab and sweep the brushes across the paper to get different designs. Talk about the patterns and textures they are making. Ask open ended questions about their painting to encourage creative thinking and language skills. You might ask...How did you...? What if...? What did you use? Where should we hang your picture?

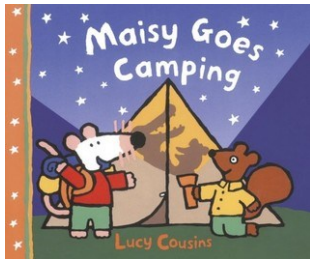

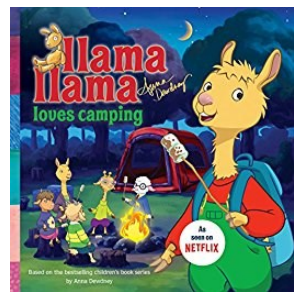
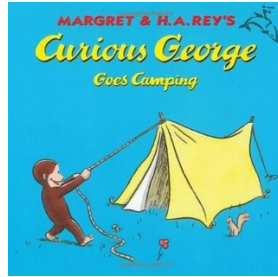


September Book Picks...



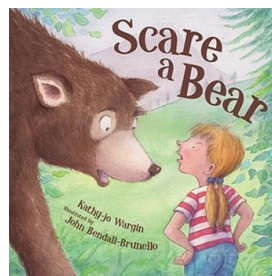

Toddler Playgroups!

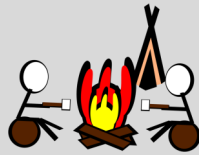

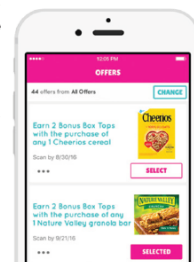

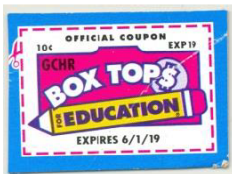
