I continued working as a direct support professional throughout my college years and went on to obtain my degree in Healthcare Administration.

Following my graduation from college, I worked in some smaller healthcare settings and did not get the same satisfaction that I had when I was working directly with people as a direct support professional. Ultimately, I returned to the field and took a job at a day service provider as a Qualified Intellectual Disability Professional (QIDP). I continued to work with individuals and various Service and Support Administrators from multiple counties. In 2015 Stark DD hired me as an SSA.

Currently, my role has transitioned from SSA to Investigative Agent. By having the opportunity to make this transition, it has allowed me to continue advocating for our individuals to ensure that they continue to have their own voice regarding their personal health and safety so they can continue to have a safe and healthy life.
