Mary is always very willing to try different tasks too. For example, although shooting a ball at a regulation height 10' basketball hoop is a real challenge for her, that is the one she always goes too instead of a









basket that is available to her. Mary is truly an inspiration to all!"

Through her school years, Stark DD has helped Mary by working with her to improve her use of an augmented communication device to help her let people know what she needs. Stark DD has also provided her with occupational/physical therapy, and adapted physical education services to build her core strength so she can participate fully in any activity.

"Whether it is bowling with the Stark Strikers All-County Bowling League, or interacting with her friends, she is motivated, persistent and always open to trying new things," said her classroom teacher.

Mary works hard in all areas during her school day, but is most excited when going to work with the Community Education Department. Mary prefers work that involves art or helping others. She has also increased her physical stamina and is able to stand while working for longer time periods.
