




MANDATED RESPONSIBILITIES

Fund, Plan, and Monitor Services

We **FUND** services and supports and our commitment extends for the life of a person with a disability.

We **PLAN** and coordinate the supports for people with disabilities in accordance to what is important to and for them.

We **MONITOR** the services and supports for people with disabilities to ensure that they are getting what they want and need. Priority #1 is that they are healthy and safe.







Stark DD has worked hard to maximize taxpayers' dollars, while offering vital services and supports to the people we serve. Through grant programs, maximizing federal and state funding, and implementing more cost saving reductions, we are stretching local taxpayer dollars and trying to do more with less. As we focus on our mandated responsibilities of funding, coordinating and monitoring life-long supports, we are allocating the resources we receive to support people in home and community based settings.

As you review our financials, we are committed to our goal that every decision we make will result in a 2023 levy renewal request that results in no new taxes.

Scenario: An Individual's Annual Budget for Services

Day Program - 16% Total Cost: Stark DD pays \$ 4,540 Medicaid pays **Transportation - 9%** \$ 7,331 Total Cost: Stark DD pays \$ 2,712 \$ 4,619 Medicaid pays **Residential - 75%** Total Cost: \$57,827 \$21,390 Stark DD pays Medicaid pays \$36,437







Making a difference one person at a time

A Home and Community Based Service (HCBS) Waiver is one way people with disabilities pay for the services they need. A waiver pays for services through Medicaid. Once a person receives a HCBS waiver, it stays with them for a lifetime as long as eligibility requirements are met. Stark DD is responsible for paying approximately 40% of the HCBS Waiver costs for the services and supports and the federal government pays the rest. We are often able to get people with disabilities the services they need without a Medicaid waiver.
