February Family Fun

Valentine Soap Foam

Here's What You'll Need:

Dish soap Water Liquid Watercolors (or food coloring) Blender or hand mixer Cornstarch (optional to help the bubbles last longer)

In a blender or mixing bowl, add 2 tablespoons of dish soap to 1/4 cup of water. Add in washable liquid water-colors, if you don't have liquid watercolors, you can use food coloring, but be careful about it staining. Blend the mixture to create a pink soap foam that fills the

blender. Scoop the soap foam out of the blender and transfer it to a large container. You can make as much as you desire. You can hide small objects (animals, toys, etc.) in the foam for your child to find or just let them explore the foam.



Valentine Yogurt Parfait

This strawberry yogurt parfait is a yummy snack and a perfect Valentine's Day treat!

Ingredients:

crumbs

2 cups strawberry yogurt 1 cup crushed graham cracker

1 cup quartered strawberries A few shakes of pink, red, and white sprinkles



Grab two serving dishes or cups, and put 1/3 cup of your yogurt in the bottom. Top that with a layer of graham cracker crumbs then a layer of strawberries. Repeat. Cut a heart out of a few strawberries and place on top. Add some sprinkles and serve.

Optional: you could use teddy grahams, granola or any crunchy cereal instead of crushed graham crackers. You could also top with heart shaped fruit bites or candy hearts for an extra special treat.

Puffy Paint Heart Valentines

Homemade puffy paint is easy to make, and is a fun art process for kids and a cool science experiment too. You just need a microwave and a few kitchen ingredients to make it.

Here's What You'll Need:

1 tbsp. self-rising flour
Food coloring in the colors of your choice
1 tbsp. salt
Little bit of water (start with 1/4 tsp per color)
Cardstock or thin cardboard
Heart shaped cookie cutters
Paint brushes or Qtips





To make the paint: Combine flour and salt in a small bowl. Add a little bit of water and stir until you get a smooth thin paste. Add food coloring and mix well.

If you want to make Puffy Heart Valentines place cookie cutters on the paper and allow your child to fill it with paint (remove the cookie cutter(s) before microwaving). You can also let them dip cookie cutters into the paint and onto the paper. When your child is happy with their work it is time for some science magic! Put it into the microwave for 30 seconds and watch your painting puff up! Your artwork will be warm when you remove it from the microwave, but it will be completely set.




