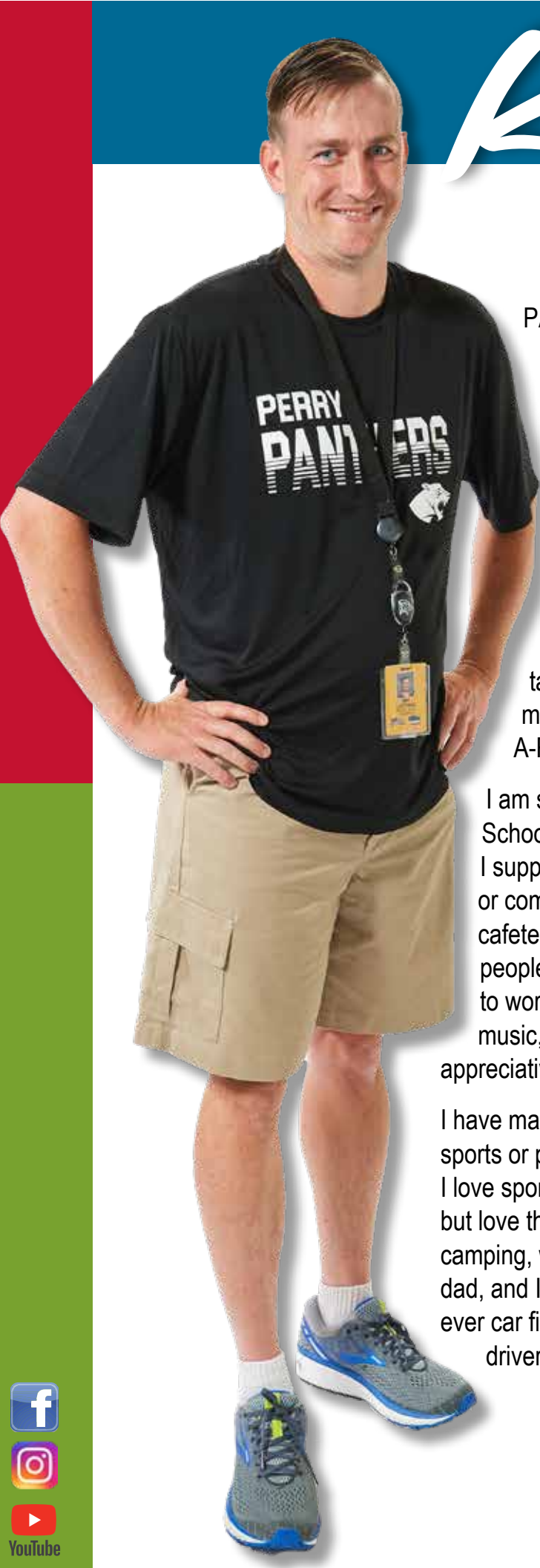
My Story

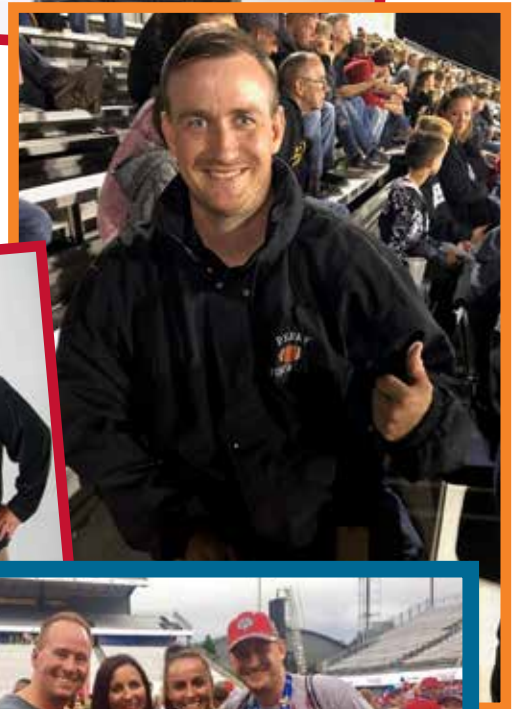
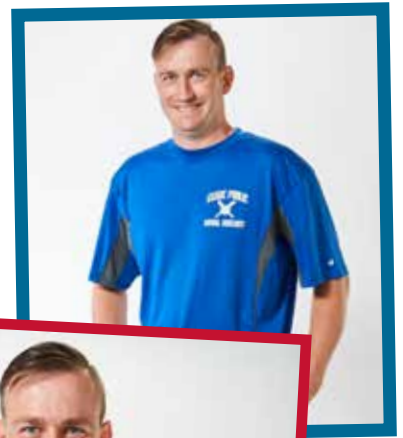
