Family Fun Ideas

COLOR SORTING FALL SENSORY BIN

Make a fall sensory bin using pom poms of different fall colors. Young children can handle them easily and appreciate their soft texture. They are fun to pick up with the fingers or scooped with tongs or spoons. They fall gently when they are dropped and fit nicely into different containers. Use small containers or cups and have your little one sort them by color or just fill a cup up then have them dump them back in. You can add in other fall items as well, small fabric or foam leaves, plastic pumpkins or fall colored wooden beads.





COOL WHIP PAINT

Materials:

Tub of whipped topping (cool whip)

Muffin tin or small plastic bowls

Food coloring

Paint brushes (or let them finger paint)

Take the tub of delicious unhealthy goodness (aka Cool Whip) and put a spoonful in each muffin tin or each plastic bowl. Mix each dollop with a few squirts of food coloring. Your child can even help squeeze in the food coloring and help stir it into the whipped topping and watch it change color.

Put the "paint" and your little one into the tub (no water) and *let the games begin*

Clean up is a breeze....simply fill the tub with warm water and wash the mess off your child and tub!

PB and J Chex™ Trail Mix

- 2 1/2cups Rice Chex cereal
- 2 1/2 cups Corn Chex cereal
- 1 cup peanut butter filled pretzel pieces
- 1 cup dry roasted peanuts
- 1/2 cup dried blueberries or dried cherries
- 1/2 cup yogurt-covered raisins
- 1/2 cup peanut butter baking chips

PREPARATION

In large bowl, mix all ingredients. Store in airtight container.

Peanut butter filled pretzels are found packaged in the snack aisle of the grocery store. If you're unable to locate them, regular pretzel twists will also work in this snack mix.

Yogurt-covered cranberries are a great alternative to yogurt-covered raisins.
