Mayor Kathy Catazaro-Perry and William Green, Stark DD Superintendent, will welcome people with disabilities, families, friends and supporters at center court beginning at 10:30 am. This event is free and open to the public.



As the parent of a child with Down syndrome, Mayor Catazaro-Perry values community inclusion and the support that Stark DD brings to her family. She will lead the parade of walkers throughout the mall after a brief welcome.

During the walk, visitors can stop by interactive stations throughout the one-mile indoor mall loop to learn about Stark DD services provided to more than 4,100 children and adults with intellectual/developmental disabilities living in our community. Stations include: Early Intervention referrals, age appropriate crafts, blood pressure checks, Hands Only CPR demonstrations, and voter registration information. People who may be interested in a career as a Direct Support Professional (DSP) for people with disabilities can learn about current career opportunities. Stark DD's Help for Good t-shirts will also be available for purchase. Shirts are \$10 each, cash or check only.
